# Charge Conference TODAY! Sunday, October 20, 2024, 9:40 am

The Board of Trustees has another urgent matter that requires a Charge Conference for the approval of the expenditures of up to \$20,000 for the replacement of HVAC system in the Fellowship Hall.

The scope of the work includes replacing two furnaces, coils, and condensers, labor, reinforcement of attic floor, and additional lighting. The work, to be done by Darren Malone retired pipefiter/plumber and heating, and his brother, Toby Malone, retired Trane HVAC technician, is expected to cost \$16,000. The additional \$4,000 is overages and will not be spent if not needed.

Please bring your questions to the Charge Conference where Tim Kreutter, Trustee Chairperson, and Darren Malone can answer them.

All members and friends of the church are invited to attend. However, only church members may vote on the proposal.


